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Request for Proposal/Letter of Intent To Interested / Qualified Providers

Project Type: *Transportation Services – Stanislaus County*

Deadline for Submission: *September 21, 2018*

Background: Valley Mountain Regional Center (VMRC) is a private, non-profit corporation that contracts with the State of California to provide diagnostic, evaluation, case management, and early intervention services to people with developmental disabilities. VMRC purchases essential services for people with developmental disabilities. Additional background information about VMRC is available on our website located at <http://www.vmrc.net/index.htm>

Description of Project:

Valley Mountain Regional Center (VMRC) has a need for a qualified transportation company to provide daily round trip bus service for VMRC consumers attending a Modesto based day program.

Provider will need to be equipped to serve 60-100 ambulatory and non-ambulatory passengers from various parts of the County. Service is a split shift system providing AM trips from consumer residences to the program and PM trips to pick-up consumers and return them to their residences.

The provider will be required to provide vehicles (10-25 passenger vehicles only), drivers and bus aides/attendants*. Minimum acceptable fleet size is 10 vehicles. Vehicles must be in compliance with California Vehicle Code and meet all Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards.

No start-up funding is associated with this project.

Maximum Rate of Compensation is \$24.62 per passenger per day.

**Additional compensation for approved bus aides as determined by VMRC.*

Interested parties are invited to submit a letter of Intent and an application packet for the development and operation of the proposed service to VMRC by September 21, 2018.

Targeted start date for service is: **November 1, 2018**

Qualifications/ Eligibility of Applicants:

Applicants must have current and appropriate Licensing and Insurance as a For-Hire Passenger Carrier. Selected applicant will be required to submit copies of licensing, insurance, Vehicle DOT or PUC registration and most current CHP Terminal Inspection.

Must have a minimum of five (5) years previous experience as a For-Hire Passenger Carrier and a minimum of three (3) years providing transit services for individuals with developmental disabilities. Prior experience working with a Regional Center is preferred.

Application Package:

All applicants must include the following in their application:

1. Letter of Intent typed and double-spaced, in English, including:
 - A) Applicant’s philosophy and values.
 - B) Statement of qualifications and business history.
 - C) A detailed description of the proposed service to be delivered and the applicant’s approach to services for the identified clientele.
2. A section on equity and diversity that shall include, but shall not be limited to:
 - A) A statement outlining the applicant’s plan to serve diverse populations, including, but not limited to, culturally and linguistically diverse populations;
 - B) Examples of the applicant’s commitment to addressing the needs of those diverse populations; and
 - C) Any additional information that the applicant deems relevant to issues of equity and diversity.
3. Training curriculum for transit operations and for sensitivity training in serving individuals with developmental disabilities.
4. Applicant resume(s) of business owner(s) and/or business partners and proof of appropriate licenses/certifications of the business.

Criteria for Selection:

A Review Committee will evaluate each applicant’s RFP Application Packet and may request an interview prior to making its final selection. Applicants should be prepared to answer questions about the contents of the Application Packet and details regarding the proposed service before a panel of Review Committee members. The applicant’s demonstrated commitment to serving people with developmental disabilities will be given special consideration.

Reservation of Rights:

VMRC reserves the right to select a provider for the services described in this Request for Proposal without further negotiations. VMRC may, at its sole discretion, select no applicant for these services if, in its determination, no applicant is sufficiently responsive to the need.

Costs for Proposal Submission:

Applicants responding to this Request for Proposal shall bear all costs associated with the development and submission of their RFP Application Packet. No costs shall be charged to VMRC, the Department of Developmental Services, or the State of California.

Deadline:

RFP Application Packets must be received no later than **September 21, 2018 at 5:00 P.M.** Application Packets will be stamped with the date and time of receipt. RFP Application Packets with time/date stamps and postmarks after **September 21, 2018 at 5:00 P.M.** will not be accepted and will be returned to the applicant. Faxed or emailed submissions will not be accepted.
